

M Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General - all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

The intention is for any alcohol served to be in the form of sorbet or ice cream and within hot drinks. The objective is to sell these menu items to promote and support the Barti Ddu Rum brand, interested visitors will be directed to other licenced retailers (not ours, eg a licensed shop in Pembroke) to purchase full bottles of Barti Ddu Rum. It is not in our interest to sell large volumes of frozen desert or drinks to any point which may be excessive for an individual. The idea is purely for promotional purpose and to have point of difference on the menu at Café Mor to attract visitors.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

As above we have no intention to promote or influence visitors to consume alcohol to excess. The sale of alcohol will mainly be limited to within sorbets and ice cream, the nature of which will not attract excessive consumption.

Opening hours are during the summer only when it is light.

c) Public safety

We will operate a challenge 25 policy so no persons under the age of 18 are served alcohol. Any items containing alcohol will be clearly marked. Staff will be trained to operate the challenge 25 policy and be informed on products containing alcohol.

Regularly serviced fire extinguishing equipment is stored on site as well as a first aid kit. There is also a mobile telephone on site for any emergency calls.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

The percentage of sales of items containing alcohol will be very small compared to the size of the menu as a whole, so will cause no additional disruption to visitors and residence to normal business practice as before.

e) The protection of children from harm

We will operate a challenge 25 policy so no persons under the age of 18 are served alcohol. Any items containing alcohol will be clearly marked. Staff will be trained to operate the challenge 25 policy and be informed on products containing alcohol.

 - (iv) self-sufficient e.g. bank statements.

Family members of European Economic Area nationals who are studying or financially independent must also provide evidence that the European Economic Area national and any family members hold comprehensive sickness insurance in the UK. This can include a private medical insurance policy, an EHIC card or an S1, S2 or S3 form.


Original documents must not be sent to licensing authorities. If the document copied is a passport, a copy of the following pages should be provided:-

- (i) any page containing the holder's personal details including nationality;
- (ii) any page containing the holder's photograph;
- (iii) any page containing the holder's signature;
- (iv) any page containing the date of expiry; and
- (v) any page containing information indicating the holder has permission to enter or remain in the UK and is permitted to work.

If the document is not a passport, a copy of the whole document should be provided.

Your right to work will be checked as part of your licensing application and this could involve us checking your immigration status with the Home Office. We may otherwise share information with the Home Office. Your licence application will not be determined until you have complied with this guidance.
