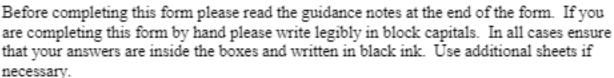

Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

## a) General - all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

When using the premises in exercise of the licence, the Designated Premises Supervisor or Premises Licence Holder shall at all times comply with the licence conditions and shall only hold the type of licensable activities specified in the licence.

The Designated Premises Supervisor or Premises Licence Holder shall ensure that any Constable, Licensing Officer or authorised officer of the authority or of the fire authority acting under lawful authority is allowed free access to the premises and the licenced area at all times for the purpose of inspection.

The supply of alcohol made under the Premises Licence shall be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

## b) The prevention of crime and disorder

No drugs are permitted on the premises and any found will be stored securely until provided to Dyfed Powys Police.

Any patrons acting in an inappropriate manner will be asked to leave. CCTV is installed at the premises and images are retained for a minimum of 31 days.

#### c) Public safety

All exit doors shall be constructed and maintained so as to be easily and fully openable and all padlocks, chains or other security devices are to be removed and all fitted locks are to be unlocked and all barrel bolts are to be withdrawn and removed prior to the premises being opened for licensable activities and such padlocks, chains, locks, barrel bolts and other security devices are to remain disengaged throughout the period that the premises are open for licensable activities and until all persons attending the premises have left.

All exit doors shall be clearly identified by an exit sign of the graphic design with any wording i.e. "EXIT" being supplementary.

All exit doors and exit routes shall be physically inspected and tested prior to the premises being open for licensable activities. A record of inspection shall be entered as soon as practicable into the register, clearly identifying the person who carried out the inspection and test.

The Designated Premises Supervisor or Premises Licence Holder shall ensure compliance with all fire prevention and other fire safety measures as required by the fire authority.

Adequate and suitable fire fighting equipment shall be provided, maintenance and sited to the satisfaction of the fire authority and such equipment shall be inspected annually by a competent person who is qualified to maintain such equipment to a recognised standard. A record of inspection shall be entered as soon as practicable into the register, clearly identifying the person who carried out the inspection and test.

All fire fighting equipment shall be inspected prior to the premises being opened for licensable activities. A record of inspection shall be entered as soon as practicable into the register, clearly identifying the person who carried out the inspection and test.

All electrical installations at the premises including wiring, fittings and appliances shall be maintained in a safe condition to the satisfaction of the authorities.

Fire safety signs will be adequately illuminated.

All bottles and glasses will be removed from public areas as soon as reasonably practicable after they are finished with or empty.

A fully stocked first aid kit will be kept at the premises.

## d) The prevention of public nuisance

All toilets shall be kept in good order and repair and be properly and effectively cleaned, lit, ventilated and supplied with hot and cold running water, soap and adequate hand-drying facilities and in the case of female toilets adequate provision shall be made for the disposal of sanitary dressings.

The premises shall be kept in a clean and tidy condition to the satisfaction of the authority.

The Designated Premises Supervisor or Premises Licence Holder shall take all steps reasonably practicably to prevent a noise nuisance at any neighbouring property during the hours of operation and as patrons leave the premises. Doors and windows will be kept closed as far as reasonably practicable to reduce the noise impact from the licenced premises at neighbouring properties. The Designated Premises Supervisor or Premises Licence Holder shall display

prominent, clear and legible notices at all exists requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.

The Designated Premises Supervisor or Premises Licence Holder shall ensure that instructions are given to staff to request the patrons leaving the premises do so in a quiet and orderly manner.

Noise levels will be monitored.

Combined fighting sports – defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts – are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
- Live music: no licence permission is required for:
  - a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
  - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
  - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
  - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
  - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
  - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
  - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
  - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

Applicants must demonstrate that they have an entitlement to work in the UK and are not subject to a condition preventing them from doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity. They do this in one of two ways: 1) by providing with this application copies or scanned copies of the documents listed below (which do not need to be certified), or 2) by providing their 'share code' to enable the licensing authority to carry out a check using the Home Office online right to work checking service (see below).

### Documents which demonstrate entitlement to work in the UK

- An expired or current passport showing the holder, or a person named in the passport
  as the child of the holder, is a British citizen or a citizen of the UK and Colonies

- A Registration Certificate or document certifying permanent residence issued by the Home Office to a national of a European Economic Area country or Switzerland.
- A Permanent Residence Card issued by the Home Office to the family member of a national of a European Economic Area country or Switzerland.
- A current Biometric Immigration Document (Biometric Residence Permit) issued by the Home Office to the holder indicating that the person named is allowed to stay indefinitely in the UK, or has no time limit on their stay in the UK.
- A current passport endorsed to show that the holder is exempt from immigration control, is allowed to stay indefinitely in the UK, has the right of abode in the UK, or has no time limit on their stay in the UK.
- A current Immigration Status Document issued by the Home Office to the holder
  with an endorsement indicating that the named person is allowed to stay indefinitely
  in the UK or has no time limit on their stay in the UK, when produced in
  combination with an official document giving the person's permanent National
  Insurance number and their name issued by a Government agency or a previous
  employer.
- A birth or adoption certificate issued in the UK, when produced in combination
  with an official document giving the person's permanent National Insurance number
  and their name issued by a Government agency or a previous employer.
- A birth or adoption certificate issued in the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man or Ireland when produced in combination with an official document giving the person's permanent National Insurance number and their name issued by a Government agency or a previous employer.
- A certificate of registration or naturalisation as a British citizen, when produced in combination with an official document giving the person's permanent National Insurance number and their name issued by a Government agency or a previous employer.
- A current passport endorsed to show that the holder is allowed to stay in the UK and
  is currently allowed to work and is not subject to a condition preventing the holder
  from doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity.
- A current Biometric Immigration Document (Biometric Residence Permit) issued by the Home Office to the holder which indicates that the named person can currently

stay in the UK and is allowed to work relation to the carrying on of a licensable activity.

- A current Residence Card issued by the Home Office to a person who is not a
  national of a European Economic Area state or Switzerland but who is a family
  member of such a national or who has derivative rights or residence.
- A current Immigration Status Document containing a photograph issued by the
  Home Office to the holder with an endorsement indicating that the named person may
  stay in the UK, and is allowed to work and is not subject to a condition preventing the
  holder from doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity when
  produced in combination with an official document giving the person's permanent
  National Insurance number and their name issued by a Government agency or a
  previous employer.
- A Certificate of Application, less than 6 months old, issued by the Home Office under regulation 18(3) or 20(2) of the Immigration (European Economic Area)
   Regulations 2016, to a person who is not a national of a European Economic Area state or Switzerland but who is a family member of such a national or who has derivative rights of residence.
- Reasonable evidence that the person has an outstanding application to vary their
  permission to be in the UK with the Home Office such as the Home Office
  acknowledgement letter or proof of postage evidence, or reasonable evidence that the
  person has an appeal or administrative review pending on an immigration decision,
  such as an appeal or administrative review reference number.
- Reasonable evidence that a person who is not a national of a European Economic
  Area state or Switzerland but who is a family member of such a national or who has
  derivative rights of residence in exercising treaty rights in the UK including:
  - evidence of the applicant's own identity such as a passport,
  - evidence of their relationship with the European Economic Area family member – e.g. a marriage certificate, civil partnership certificate or birth certificate, and
  - evidence that the European Economic Area national has a right of permanent residence in the UK or is one of the following if they have been in the UK for more than 3 months:
    - working e.g. employment contract, wage slips, letter from the employer,
    - self-employed e.g. contracts, invoices, or audited accounts with a bank.
    - studying e.g. letter from the school, college or university and evidence of sufficient funds; or
    - (iv) self-sufficient e.g. bank statements.

Family members of European Economic Area nationals who are studying or financially independent must also provide evidence that the European Economic Area national and any family members hold comprehensive sickness insurance in the UK. This can include a private medical insurance policy, an EHIC card or an S1, S2 or S3 form.

If the document is not a passport, a copy of the whole document should be provided.

Your right to work will be checked as part of your licensing application and this could involve us checking your immigration status with the Home Office. We may otherwise share information with the Home Office. Your licence application will not be determined until you have complied with this guidance.

#### Home Office online right to work checking service

As an alternative to providing a copy of the documents listed above, applicants may demonstrate their right to work by allowing the licensing authority to carry out a check with the Home Office online right to work checking service.

To demonstrate their right to work via the Home Office online right to work checking service, applicants should include in this application their 9-digit share code (provided to them upon accessing the service at <a href="https://www.gov.uk/prove-right-to-work">https://www.gov.uk/prove-right-to-work</a>) which, along with the applicant's date of birth (provided within this application), will allow the licensing authority to carry out the check.

In order to establish the applicant's right to work, the check will need to indicate that the applicant is allowed to work in the United Kingdom and is not subject to a condition preventing them from doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity.

An online check will not be possible in all circumstances because not all applicants will have an immigration status that can be checked online. The Home Office online right to work checking service sets out what information and/or documentation applicants will need in order to access the service.
