NAME	POLICY & PRE-DECISION OVERVIEW AND SCRUTINY COMMITTEE
PURPOSE	The Policy & Pre-decision Overview and Scrutiny Committee will review and scrutinise policies, plans and strategies prior to decision by Cabinet.
ROLE & FUNCTION	To undertake pre-decision scrutiny of policies, plans and strategies in order to contribute to the quality and robustness of Cabinet decision-making.
	To provide assurance that Cabinet decision-making is compliant with the Well-being of Future Generations (Wales) Act 2015, having taken account of the 'sustainable development' principle and 5 ways of working (long-term, preventative, involving, collaborative and integrated), and other statutory requirements as appropriate (e.g. Equality Act 2010).
	To ensure non-executive Member involvement in the Council's budget policy and planning framework through a standing Finance Panel.
REMIT & SCOPE	<ul> <li>Cabinet forward work programme</li> <li>Proposals for services changes, transformation and / or efficiencies</li> <li>Integrated Impact Assessments</li> <li>Strategies and plans, as appropriate</li> <li>Development of and planning for annual budget and Council Tax proposals through the Finance Panel</li> </ul>
PROCEDURE	The Committee will conduct its proceedings in accordance with the Overview and Scrutiny Procedure Rules set out in Section 7 of the Council's Constitution.
MEMBERSHIP	There will be 13 Members on the Committee.
FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS	The Policy & Pre-decision Overview and Scrutiny Committee will meet at least 5 times per municipal year.
