







TENBY ROAD ACCESS INFORMATION - SUNDAY 9 SEPTEMBER — PLAN AHEAD

Tenby will host athlete registration, EXPO, transition, IRONKIDS and the swim, bike and run course for IRONMAN Wales. Temporary road closures will be in place during race week to ensure the safety of athletes and the public. These legal road closures are implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994, and apply to all vehicles and bikes not involved in the event.

- Pedestrians **CAN** cross the course at any time when safe to do so.
- Essential access for carers will be facilitated. Please contact <u>wales@ironmanroadaccess.com</u> as soon as possible if access required.
- There are **NO RESTRICTIONS** at any time to the emergency services
- Tuesday 4 Thursday 6 September there are no road closures in place but there will be build and event activity at Five Arches Car Park and the Rectory Car Park throughout the week, and also for event de-rig Monday 3 September Tuesday 11 September.
