

Statement of Reason:

The proposals are being promoted following representation/petition from the local community following a number of rear end collisions. Slade is a linear development on the North West of Haverfordwest with a number of properties fronting the A487.

The review took into account the accident history, speed survey data, geometry of the road, and other factors including junctions, type of activity along its length and user group. The review concluded that the current limit should be reduced to 40mph in order to ensure that a safe and consistent speed distribution is maintained along this route.
