# THE COUNTY OF PEMBROKE (SOUTH ROAD, PEMBROKE) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2022 AND NOTICE TO PROVIDE TRAFFIC CALMING FEATURES.

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Pembrokeshire County Council propose to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule and (2) and parts III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 ("the Act"), the effect of which will be to prohibit driving (except for Pedal Cycles) along that length of road contained in the Schedule 1 to this notice. The Council also propose, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980, to provide a raised crossing as detailed in Schedule 2 to this notice. It is intended to install double yellow line waiting restrictions either side of the raised crossing to prohibit parking as detailed in schedule 3 to this notice.



#### STATEMENT OF REASON

Proposals have been developed to address residents concerns in respect of increased through traffic "Rat Running", vehicle speeds and pedestrian safety on South Road.

The proposal includes the provision of a raised crossing for pedestrians. Removable bollards will be installed to create a closing of the highway and will prevent motorists from rat running to & from St Daniels Hill/Monkton. In the event of an emergency or when an alternative route is blocked, vehicular access maybe re instated. Full access to pedal cycles will remain, allowing cyclists to proceed over the full length of South Road. To ensure both turning heads remain clear of parked vehicles, it is also proposed that on street parking restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) are also implemented.

These measures are being promoted as part of a package of road safety inventions within the Safe Routes in Community Fund.

THE PEMBROKESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (Hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, Hereby make the following Order.

- No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or qualified Traffic Management Operative under instruction, cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to travel along the lengths of road set out in the Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 2. The Pembrokeshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011 and subsequent variations will be amended as per the details in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 4. This Order may be cited as "The County Of Pembroke (South Road, Pembroke) (Prohibition of Driving and Traffic Restrictions) Order 2022 and Shall come into operation on the \*\* day of \*\*\*\* 2022
