

**THE COUNTY OF PEMBROKE (VARIOUS ROADS, PEMBROKE)**

**(20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022**

**AND NOTICE TO PROVIDE TRAFFIC CALMING FEATURES**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Pembrokeshire County Council propose to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) and parts III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 ("the Act"), the effect of which will be to extend the existing 20mph speed limit a further 360 metres south on Grove Hill and introduce a 20mph limit on the A4139.

The Council also propose, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980, to provide traffic calming features within the zone as detailed in Schedule 2.

**20mph speed limit**

<b>Road</b>	<b>Length</b>
Class III (C3141) Grove Hill	From a point 15 metres north of Grove Drive to a point 138 metres north of Grove Way.
A4139, Orange Way	From a point 33 metres south east of the junction with the B4319 to a point 31 metres north east of Grove Hill.

**Traffic Calming Features**

<b>Ref</b>	<b>Location</b>	<b>Type</b>
	Class III (C3141) Grove Hill	
i)	At a point 166 metres south of the junction with Grove Drive.	Priority system – with priority in the southbound lane.
ii)	At a point 280 metres south of the junction with Grove Drive.	Priority system – with priority in the southbound lane.
iii)	At a point 60 metres south of the junction with Grove Drive.	Road Hump 65mm in height for a length 3.7 metres (full carriageway width)

## **Statement of Reason**

The proposal is being promoted as part of the Phase 3 Footway Improvements on the C3141 – Grove Hill.

The work is being funded by Welsh Government as part of the Safe Routes in Communities and forms part of a package of measures being implemented in the vicinity of the School.

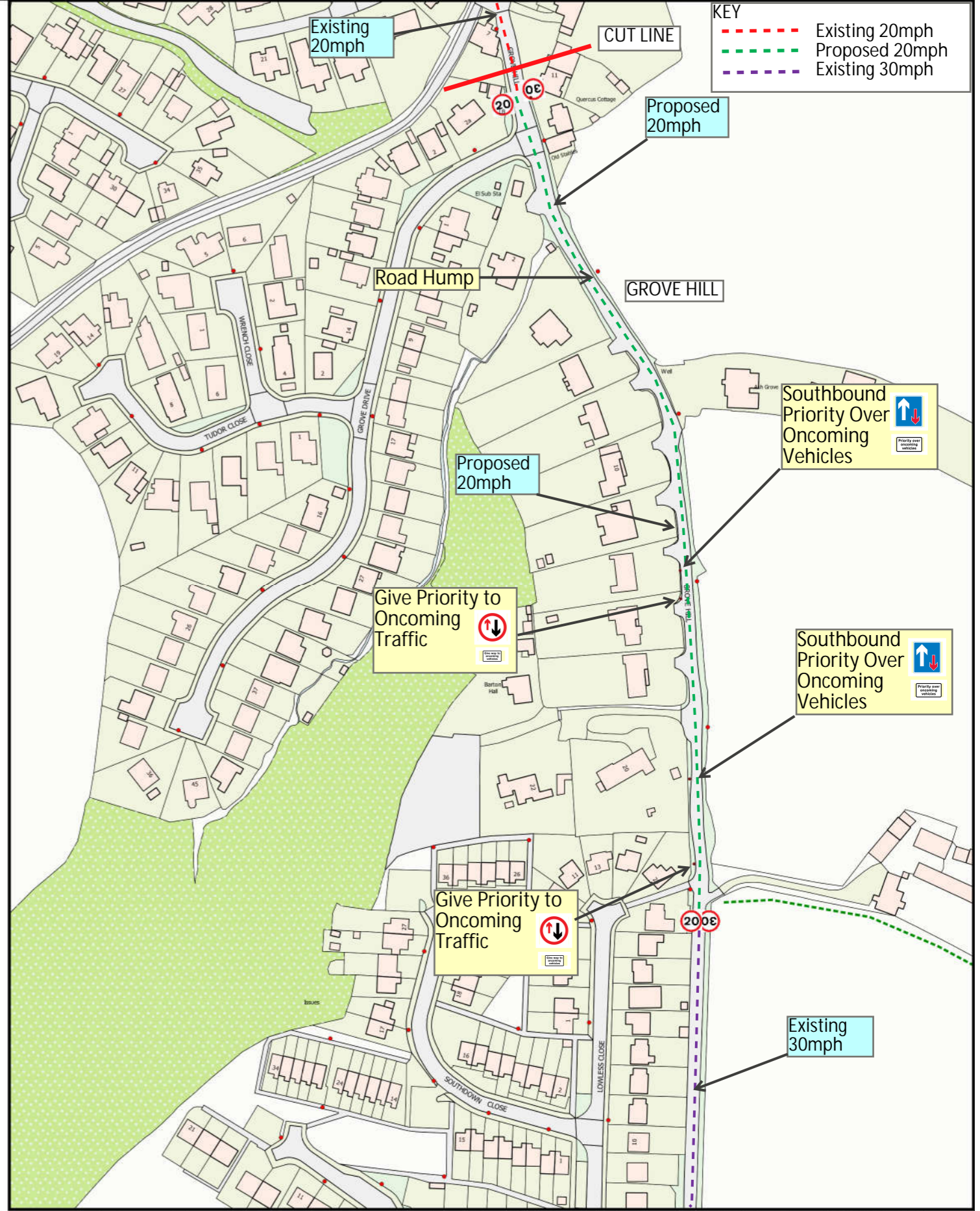
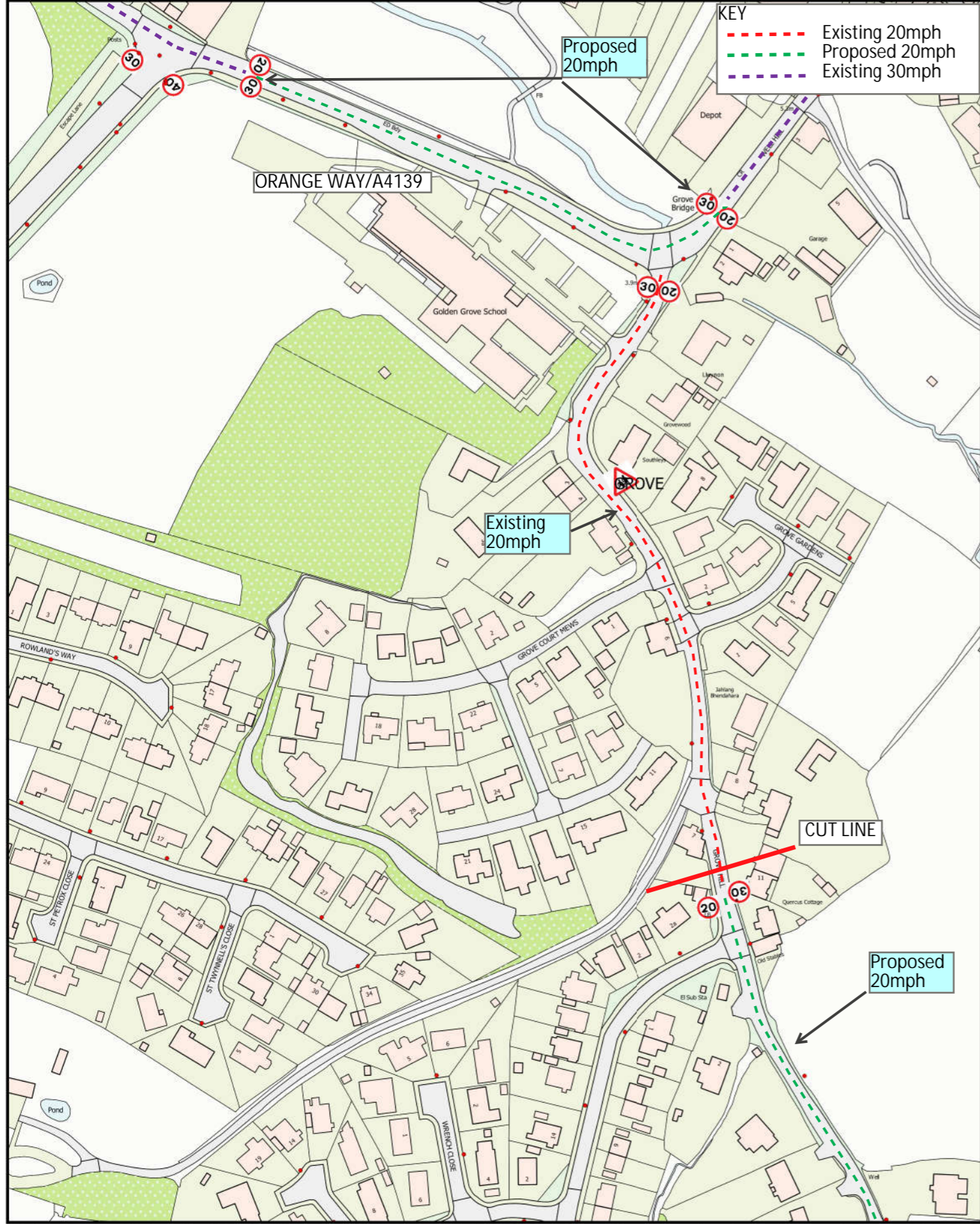




# PEMBROKE VARIOUS ROADS, PROPOSED 20 MPH & TRAFFIC CALMING (Indicative Plan)

(20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022**

The Pembrokeshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Schedule 1 / Ref 1.67.0 / Location Pembroke - Grove Hill of 'The County of Pembroke (Various Roads) (Restricted Roads & 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2017' will be revoked insofar as it relates to the length of road contained in the Schedule to this Order;
3. This Order may be cited as "The County of Pembroke (Various Roads, Pembroke) (20mph Speed limit) Order 2022 and shall come into operation on the \*\*\*\*th day of \*\*\*\* Two thousand and Twenty Two.
