

**THE COUNTY OF PEMBROKE (A487 & ADJOINING ROADS AT PELCOMB CROSS)
(30MPH & 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022**

NOTICE is hereby given that Pembrokeshire County Council propose to make an Order under Section 84 and part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"). The effect of the Order will be to impose a 40mph limit through the junction on the A487 Haverfordwest to St Davids Road and a 30mph limited as specified in the Schedule to this order.

The proposals are being promoted following a speed limit review through the village.

Statement of Reason

A speed limit review has been carried out on the A487 at Pelcomb Cross. The review took into account the collision history, speed survey data and geometry of the road. The review concluded that the current speed limit should be reduced to 40mph through the junction and 30mph on the residential roads.

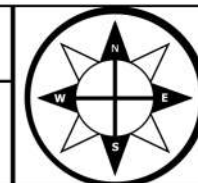


A487 Pelcomb Cross

The Pembrokeshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order.
3. This Order may be cited as "The County of Pembroke (A487 & Adjoining Roads at Pelcomb Cross (30mph & 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2022" and shall come into operation on the **th day of **** Two Thousand and Twenty Two.
