

PEMBROKESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2011 (VARIATION NO.23) ORDER 2022

The Pembrokeshire County Council ('the Council') in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46,49, 53, 101, 102, 124 and part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended, the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers of the Act, and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of March 2022 and may be cited as the Pembrokeshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011 (Variation No. 23) Order 2022.

2. The Pembrokeshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2011 ("the Consolidation Order") including the schedules contained therein and subsequent variations are hereby varied or amended as follows:-

1 Amendment of Schedule 2

In schedule 2.18 - No Waiting 8pm-7am Caravans and Motor Caravans, insert:-

A487 Newgale

North side – the northern layby located at a point approximately 275 metres east of the junction with Welsh Road.

South side – i) the southern layby located at a point approximately 70 metres east of the junction with Welsh Road.

ii) the southern layby located at a point approximately 340 metres east of the junction with Welsh Road.

Welsh Road

Both sides – from the junction with the A487 at Newgale, south to its junction with the class III (C3067) road leading to Roch at Cliff Cottages.

2) Revocations

Those lengths of road contained in “the Consolidation Order” including the schedules therein and subsequent variations are hereby revoked where specifically mentioned or where the amendment as contained in this Order provides a new definition of the restriction to apply to that section of highway.
