The proposals are being promoted to support the provision of a pedestrian footway connecting the community of Pentlepoir to the Railway Station.



Statement of Reason:

The proposals are being promoted to support the provision of a pedestrian footway connecting the community of Pentlepoir to the Railway Station. The reduced speed limit will:

- improve safety to pedestrians,
- reduce land take which in turn will reduce cost,
- reduce visibility splay at the crossing points which in turn will result in reduced tree/vegetation clearance and subsequent saving in cost and time and less impact on ecology.
- reduce sign sizes as well as reduced visibility and siting distance.

The Pembrokeshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as "The County of Pembrokeshire (Class II Road B4316, Saundersfoot to Pentlepoir (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2022" and shall come into operation on the \*\*th day of \*\*\*\* Two Thousand and Twenty Two.
