	U6341 Church View		From the junction with the A4139 (E) to a point 102 metres West.

**Schedule 2 – 30mph Speed Limit**

**2. In Schedule 2 insert:**

2.15A.0	Hodgeston		
	A4139		From the junction with the U6341, West for 110 metres and 244 metres East of the junction with the U6341 Church View.

### **Statement of Reason**

The proposed 30mph speed limit will be introduced to address concerns regarding vehicle speeds and safety concerns through the village of Hodgeston and follows a speed limit review and assessment. The review took into account the extent of the built environment, accident history, speed survey data and geometry of the road and its junctions.

1. 'The County of Pembroke (Various Roads) (Restricted Roads and 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2017' shall have effect as though in Schedules 1 and 2 the following applies:

**Schedule 1 – Restricted Roads (30mph applies)**

**1. In Schedule 1 Insert:**

	U6341 Church View		From the junction with the A4139 (E) to a point 102 metres West.

**Schedule 2 – 30mph Speed Limit**

**2. In Schedule 2 insert:**

2.15A.0	Hodgeston		
	A4139		From the junction with the U6341, West for 110 metres and 244 metres East of the junction with the U6341 Church View.

2. This Order may be cited as 'The County of Pembroke (Various Roads) (Restricted Roads and 30mph Speed Limit) (Amendment No.4) Order 2022' and shall come into operation on the xxxx day of xxxxxx Two Thousand and Twenty Two.
