Good afternoon,

Mathry Community Council met to discuss the consultation on the review of the Local Development Plan 2 on the 18 November 2024.

There were two comments we wish to record:

1. The Community Council has no adverse comments with regard to the change in the village boundary to include the 2 new areas.
2. The Council proposes that Mathry be downgraded from its designation as a Service Village which the LDP2 defines as: “Each village offers a good provision of services and facilities to meet the day to day needs of their population”. This is no longer true for Mathry – in recent years it has lost its school, its post office, its café and its shops and now has only the pub and the community hall as a community facility. It clearly can no longer meet the day to day needs of its population.
