



I need a wheelchair, where can I get help in Pembrokeshire?

The responsibility for provision of wheelchairs in Wales to those with permanent or long term impairment rests with the Artificial Limb and Appliance Service (ALAS). Contact: 02920 313906.

If you require a wheelchair for long term use and meet ALAS criteria you can be referred to ALAS by a health care professional. This could be someone who knows you, like your occupational therapist, GP, nurse or physiotherapist.

If you need a wheelchair for a short term problem or a short period you can consider hiring.

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

How do we help people?

We provide short-term loans of medical equipment, for people with a disability or illness who are in crisis for a small donation of £5 p/w.

The main types of equipment provided include:

- Wheelchairs
- Backrests
- Bath seats
- walking sticks and frames
- · Commodes, bedpans and urinals.
- Riser/recline chairs
- Perching stools
- Cantilever tables
- Toilet aids

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Hywel Dda University Health Board Occupational Therapy Service in Pembrokeshire has a limited number of wheelchairs for short term loan. These wheelchairs are issued, when available, for short term use, based on the following guidelines;

The person must live in Pembrokeshire and have an immediate and essential need for a wheelchair for a short period of time.

The person has a problem with their walking, which means that they cannot safely walk, even short distances, by any other means. An assessment of their walking should have been carried out to establish if the person can walk safely with walking aids.

The person and the environment must be safe for wheelchair use. This will be assessed, prior to loan, by the OT service.

The purpose of the wheelchair provision is to:

- Enable the person to access essential facilities at home, e.g. toilet
- Reduce risk of injury to the person and/or carers
- Avoid admission to hospital or residential care or enable discharge from hospital.

Due to the nature of demand for wheelchairs it cannot be guaranteed that the occupational therapy service will always have a suitable wheelchair available, even if the person meets these guidelines. In these circumstances the OT service will try to assist in problem solving with the person/carers.

Wheelchairs are **not** loaned by the Occupational Therapy service in the following circumstances

- People visiting Pembrokeshire who have pre-existing mobility problems. They should be advised
 to bring their own wheelchair with them or directed to local organisations that loan or hire out
 wheelchairs.
- When the need for a wheelchair is for outdoor use only. They should be advised to discuss with their GP practice a referral to ALAS for their own wheelchair or directed to local organisations that loan or hire out wheelchairs.
