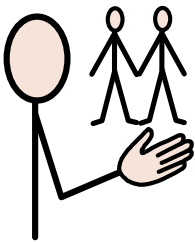
## Transition planning

You will be invited to a meeting from the school.



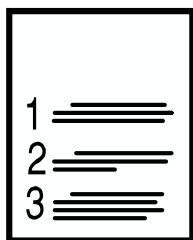
Other people will be at the meeting:

## Transition Plan.

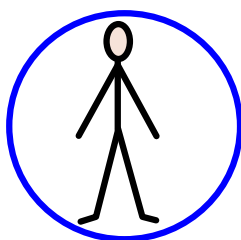
The plan includes what is available when leaving school.

- benefits.

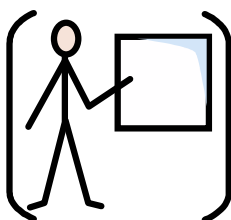

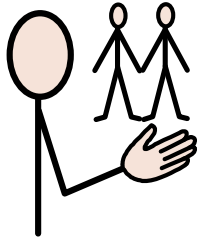
The plan will be reviewed once a year, the meeting may include:

- Health.



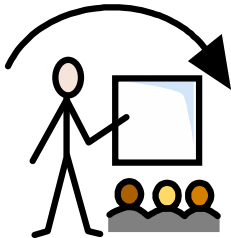

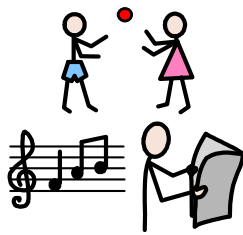

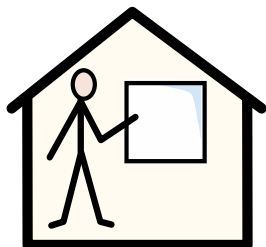

# 18 - 25



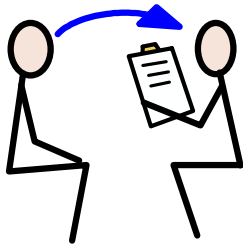
The team works with young adults from 18 to 25.

They can refer to the Health Team.

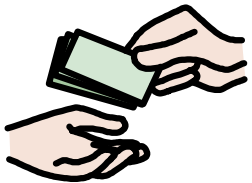
Or Managed Care Team.
