### **Description:**

I create willow sculptures, sculptural baskets, and traditional Welsh baskets. On my eco-smallholding, I annually coppice and hand process 14 varieties of willow. I also sell cuttings and plants.

Using UK Blue Faced Leicester wool as well as silk, I design and create beautiful handmade felt, sometimes using plant dyes from my garden. My products include waistcoats, hats, bags, scarves, brooches and felt making kits.

At my workshop studio there are always small range of products on sale, and in progress. Please phone me if you have something particular in mind to ensure availability. You can also order bespoke items, or book a personal or group workshop, see website for 2016 basketry and felt making courses.

**Directions:** From South Pembrokeshire (A40). Take the A478 north from Narberth towards Cardigan. About 4 miles after Glandy-Cross turn right (signposted) to Glandwr. At the village crossroads turn left. Approximately 400 metres after the bridge, the Tir-y-Gafel entrance is on the left. Go up the track to a small car park by a large turf roofed building, the 'Lammas Community Hub'. Please park here. If you have a disability please call in advance and I can meet you here. Otherwise please follow the 'Willow and Wool Crafts' sign up to the right, then down a path to the left towards a brown yurt and pink roundhouse. Please ring the bell if no-one is around. This is about a 50 metre walk.

From North Pembrokeshire (Cardigan), take the A478 south towards Tenby. About 2 miles after Crymych, turn left (signposted) to Glandwr. Follow directions as above.

**Opening times:** Thursdays 9.00am – 5.00pm at my workshop. Saturdays 10.30am – 3.30pm at the

Lammas Community Hub Livelihood Shop. Other days by prior arrangement only. April 14<sup>th</sup> – end of September 2016.

**Description:** In 1797, the last ever invasion of mainland Britain took place when a French force landed three miles west of Fishguard. The fascinating story of this event is told on a 100-foot long embroidered tapestry, designed and sewn by 80 local women. It's in a similar format and shape as the Bayeux Tapestry and is now internationally famous.

The Tapestry was commissioned as a permanent legacy of the Invasion Bicentenary in 1997. It took four years to complete and is exhibited in a purpose-built gallery attached to the Library in Fishguard Town Hall. Museum exhibits and an AV room showing films related to the making of the Tapestry are included.
