

Consultation Starts on Angle Education Proposals

A public consultation has started today (Thursday, 3rd September) on Pembrokeshire County Council's proposal to establish a new primary school for the Angle peninsula.

The County Council is proposing to close Angle VC School, Orielson CP School and Stackpole VC School, and establish a new voluntary controlled school for children aged 3 to 11.

The closing date for responses is Friday, 16th October 2015.

The findings of the consultation will be considered by the County Council before they make a decision.

There will also be a public information session at Pembroke Town Hall on Monday, 28th September from 6.30pm to 8pm, where Kate Evan-Hughes, Director for Children and Schools, will give a presentation, to be followed by a question and answer session.
