

Drop-in session to view new Welsh school plans



The plans for the proposed new Welsh-medium school in Haverfordwest will be available to view in a drop-in session on Tuesday, 20th September.

The session will take place from 3pm to 6.30pm at the Pembrokeshire Archives in Prendergast, Haverfordwest, SA61 2PE.

The school was given statutory approval by Pembrokeshire County Council in July 2016. A full planning application will be discussed by the Authority's planning committee on 4th October.

The drop-in session aims to provide anyone interested in the school with an opportunity to view the plans, ask questions to officers, and make any comments.

The school would be located at Withybush Road and proposes to provide Welsh-medium education for children between the ages of 3 and 16, as well as a Cylch Meithrin (Welsh-language playgroup), with separate entrances for the different age groups.

The aim is to create a learning environment which meets 21st century school requirements, and provide seamless Welsh-medium education for children in Pembrokeshire from pre-school to Year 11.
