

Solva information session



A further public information session is to be held in Solva this month on modified proposals for secondary education provision in the Fishguard and St Davids area.

This additional meeting follows public request.

The meeting will be held at Solva Memorial Hall on Tuesday 20th October, between 6pm and 7.30pm.

The additional session is part of a statutory consultation on a review of secondary education in the Fishguard and St Davids areas.

It supersedes previous statutory consultation and puts forward the following modified proposals.

- Designate Ysgol Bro Gwaun as a 11-16 school and to provide additional ALN provision for pupils with complex learning needs
- Discontinue Ysgol Dewi Sant, Ysgol Bro Dewi VA and Solva CP School and establish a new 3-16 Church in Wales Voluntary Aided or Voluntary Controlled school on the sites of Ysgol Bro Dewi and Ysgol Dewi Sant
- Provide post 16 provision for the above Schools in a new sixth form centre as part of a formal collaboration between the County Council and Pembrokeshire College.
