

Ysgol Harri Tudur/Henry Tudor School (Pembroke School)

A £38.3 million new build 11–19 secondary school on the site of the existing school to accommodate 1463 learners plus a 30 place Autism Unit.

The main reasons and the advantages of the scheme were:

- to improve learner outcomes at all levels and offer a rich and stimulating curriculum, so that the highest standards for all are achieved;
- to develop a learning campus environment that met 21st Century School requirements;
- to provide a learning environment that is all inclusive and aspires learners to achieve the best outcomes;
- to provide a learning campus which is welcoming and embracing to pupils, staff and the community, which are prominent and are clearly visible to the local community;
- to provide a learning campus which has IT as a core feature of educational delivery and is robust to accommodate fast developing change;
- to provide a cost effective and efficient model for delivery, removing unnecessary duplication, aligning capacity with demand (in light of demographic change), generating economies of scale and expanding economies of scope;
- to provide education in a building that is fit for purpose;
- to provide classroom space which complies with recommended areas defined in the Building Bulletin and which allows for flexibility for expanding need;
- to provide a purpose built autism unit for the County to meet current demand and need.
