

# Consultation opens on Haverfordwest secondary education



A new consultation is opening on Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> January on the future of English-medium secondary education in Haverfordwest.

The consultation proposes to:

- Close Sir Thomas Picton School and Tasker Milward VC School on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018.
- Establish a new 11-19 English medium school in Haverfordwest with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018, initially utilising both existing school sites.
- Designate Johnston CP School and Neyland CP School as feeder schools to Milford Haven School, and extend the catchment area of Milford Haven School to encompass the catchment areas of Johnston and Neyland.

It follows the consideration and subsequent refusal of previous proposals relating to English-medium secondary education in Haverfordwest.

The new consultation will supersede earlier consultations.

As a result, all those interested are urged to make their views known, as responses to previous consultations cannot be considered.
