

Downloading Files from Hwb

Locate the file you wish to download. The method for downloading documents may vary slightly depending on the file type.

PDF Files

Open the document.


Click on Download


Click on the downloaded document to open it

This will open the [Save As](#) window.


Select where you want to save the document, then click [Save](#)

Open the document.


Click on [Accessibility Mode](#). A download arrow should appear (see below)



Click on the arrow to download the document


This will open the [Save As](#) window.

Select where you want to save the document, then click [Save](#)




If the Word document you open does not have the Accessibility Mode option at the top, you may need to follow different steps to download it.
