I give notice that: Pembrokeshire County Council is intending to apply for planning permission for B2 Classification use for Unit 29/29A and for this unit to be used as a waste transfer facility where segregated recycling and residual materials will be bulked in designated bays before being loaded onto containers or artic vehicles prior to onward transportation to processors. No processing of materials is undertake on site and there is no external storage of waste undertaken at the facility.
