

Western Quayside Site

The former Ocky White department store is part of the western quayside area, which is shared with the new library and cultural centre. The site is on a key route between Haverfordwest Castle, bus station and train station, which creates the opportunity to improve the attractiveness and connectivity of the town centre. Further strategic redevelopment will provide a catalyst to rejuvenate Haverfordwest's town centre.





The Riverside - Flagship Cultural Centre

Haverfordwest's new £4.5 million county library opened on 7th December 2018. The project is expected to receive 200,000 visitors annually and has already increased footfall by 10% into town centre. The project is planned as part of Pembrokeshire County Council's regeneration framework that aims to enhance the town's offer, maximise the townscape quality and historic assets, and harness local ideas and creativity.

Glan-yr-afon – Canolfan Ddiwylliannol Flaenllaw

Agorodd y llyfrgell sir newydd yn Hwlffordd, a gostiodd £4.5 miliwn, ar 7 Rhagfyr 2018. Disgwylir i'r prosiect dderbyn 200,000 o ymwelwyr bob blwyddyn ac mae eisoes wedi ysgogi cynnydd o 10% yn nifer yr ymwelwyr i ganol y dref. Cylluniwyd y prosiect fel rhan o fframwaith adfywio Cyngor Sir Penfro, sydd â'r nod o gyfoethogi cynig y dref, gwneud y gorau o ansawdd y treflun ac asedau hanesyddol, a harneisio syniadau a chreadigrwydd lleol.

WESTERN QUAYSIDE ENHANCEMENT - OCKY WHITE & PUBLIC REALM GWELLA GLAN CEI'R GORLLEWIN - OCKY WHITE A THIR CYHOEDDUS

The redevelopment of the former Ocky White Department Store and adjacent external car park is planned as part of the wider Pembrokeshire County Council Haverfordwest masterplan framework. The project aims to reinvigorate the town centre by creating another key project adjacent to the Riverside cultural centre, further increasing footfall in the town centre, enhancing an existing pedestrian link from the Haverfordwest Castle to the train station, and creating an external public realm space for events that fits into the wider urban fabric.

Mae ailddatblygu hen Siop Adrannol Ocky White a maes parcio allanol cyfagos wedi'i gynllunio fel rhan o fframwaith uwchgynllun ehangu Cyngor Sir Penfro ar gyfer Hwlffordd. Nod y prosiect yw adfywio canol y dref trwy greu prosiect allweddol arall ger canolfan ddiwylliannol Glan-yr-afon, gan gynyddu ymhellach nifer yr ymwelwyr yng nghanol y dref, gwella'r cyswllt presennol i gerddwyr rhwng Castell Hwlffordd a'r orsaf reilffordd, a chreu gofod cyhoeddus allanol ar gyfer digwyddiadau sy'n cyd-fynd ag adeiladwaith ehangu y dref.


VIEW TO EXTERNAL SPACE - FORMER WAREHOUSE BUILDING REMOVED DARLUN O'R GOFOD ALLANOL – HEN ADEILAD WARWS WEDI'I DDYMCHWEL

The design looks to enhance the pedestrian experience. An accessible ramp and stair combination resolves the level changes between the two buildings whilst providing a natural amphitheatre or event space. A flat area surrounding the former Ocky White Department Store allows for external dining opportunities and level access across the river footbridge. By realigning the accessible parking bays and removing the former warehouse building, a space for markets is created. Urban tree planting demarcates the boundary between pedestrians and vehicles.

Nod y dyluniad yw gwella profiad cerddwyr. Mae cyfuniad o ramp a grisiau hygrych yn datrys y newid mewn lefelau rhwng y ddau adeilad gan ddarparu amffithiatr naturiol neu ofod ar gyfer digwyddiadau. Mae ardal wastad o amgylch hen Siop Adrannol Ocky White yn galluogi cyfleoedd bwytia awyr-agored a mynediad gwastad ar y bont droed ar draws yr afon. Mae cilfachau parcio hygrych wedi'u hail-alinio, ac ar ôl dymchwel yr hen adeilad warws yn llwyr, caiff man gwastad ei greu ar gyfer marchnadoedd. Caiff coed trefol eu plannu i ddynodi'r ffin rhwng cerddwyr a cherbydau.

VIEW TO EXTERNAL SPACE - FORMER WAREHOUSE BUILDING RETAINED DARLUN O'R GOFOD ALLANOL - CADW'R HEN ADEILAD WARWS

Relocating the accessible parking bays opposite the library entrance (bin store location would be found elsewhere) opens up more space on the site. The increase in space allows the opportunity to retain the former warehouse building, where a number of large entrances are installed in the existing walls to allow movement through. The roof would be removed and the space can be opened up for external dining or events space. The proposed square is enclosed by urban trees and the space is left open for markets and events.

Mae adleoli'r cilfachau parcio hygrych gyferbyn â mynedfa'r llyfrgell (ceir lleoliad ar gyfer storfa biniau mewn man arall) yn creu rhagor o le ar y safle. Mae'r cynnydd o ran gofod yn galluogi cyfle i gadw'r hen adeilad warws, lle caiff y walau presennol eu cadw a gosodir nifer o fynedfeidd mawr i alluogi symud trwy'r adeilad. Byddai'r to yn cael ei dynnu a gellir agor y lle fel man awyr-agored ar gyfer bwyta neu ddigwyddiadau. Mae'r sgwâr a gynigir wedi'i amgáu gan goed trefol ac mae'r gofod yn cael ei adael yn agored ar gyfer marchnadoedd a digwyddiadau.
