

## Timetable for the Police and Crime Commissioner elections<sup>1</sup> in England and Wales: 7 May 2020

The days which are disregarded in calculating the timetable are Saturday, Sunday, bank holidays and any day appointed for public thanksgiving or mourning.

Please be aware that the timetable may change in the event of days being appointed for public thanksgiving or mourning.

Deadline for receiving new applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy or emergency proxies)	6 days (5pm)	5pm on Wednesday 29 April
Publication of second interim election notice of alteration	Between 18 days and 6 days	Between Thursday 9 April and Wednesday 29 April (inclusive)

Last time to alter the register due to clerical error or court appeal	0 (9pm)	9pm on Thursday 7 May
