

Coronavirus Waste and Recycling Tips



Kerbside Collections



There have been no changes to the Waste and Recycling kerbside collections at present, they are deemed essential services and we are doing everything in our power to continue to provide these collections for households and businesses across Pembrokeshire whilst ensuring the health and wellbeing of our employees.

If you are experiencing issues with your waste and recycling due to the temporary closure of the Waste and Recycling Centre's please email wasteandrecycling@pembrokeshire.gov.uk and our team of Local Environment Advisors are on hand to answer any questions and provide solutions wherever we can.

Please do not burn household waste and recycling (especially plastics). Not only is it dangerous, anti-social and damaging to the environment but there is a danger of breathing in toxic fumes.

Container Hygiene

Please handle your containers with care and wash your hands thoroughly after use. We would also appreciate it if you could clean the handles and lids of your containers and bags before and after they have been emptied.

Please ensure your waste and recycling is out by 6.30am on the day of your collection.

If you need any replacement recycling containers they can be ordered via "My Account" or additional food waste bags can be requested by placing a note on top of your food waste caddy on collection days.

Bulky Waste and Recycling

Please hold on to your bulky waste and recycling and store it safely on your property



until the Waste and Recycling Centre's reopen or when bulky collections resume. If you are planning on using commercial waste operators to take your waste away, you must ensure they are authorised to carry out these collections.



Disposal of Personal Waste

Public Health Wales has issued the following advice for disposal of personal waste during the coronavirus outbreak:

- Personal waste (such as used tissues) and disposable cleaning cloths/ wipes should be placed securely within a disposable rubbish or plastic bag.
- These bags should be placed into another second bag, tied securely and kept separate from other waste.
- This should be put aside for at least 72 hours before being placed in your usual residual "grey" bags for collection.

Personal Waste must not be put into recycling.



Please keep your distance.

Our collection operatives are key essential workers and we need to keep them safe, please keep your distance and observe the 2 metre social distancing guidelines at all times.

Cofiwch sicrhau fod eich gwastraff ac ailgylchu allan erbyn 6.30am ar ddiwrnod eich casgliad.

Os bydd arnoch angen unrhyw gynwysyddion ailgylchu newydd, gallwrch eu harchebu trwy "Fy Nghyfrif" neu gallwrch ofyn am fagiau gwastraff bwyd ychwanegol trwy ddodi nodyn ar ben eich cist gwastraff bwyd ar y diwrnodau casglu.



Gwastraff ac Ailgylchu Swmpus

Daliwch eich gwastraff ac ailgylchu swmpus yn ddiogel yn eich eiddo hyd nes bydd y Canolfannau Gwastraff ac Ailgylchu'n ailagor neu gasgliadau swmpus yn ailddechrau. Gwared Gwastraff Personol

Mae lechyd Cyhoeddus Cymru wedi cyhoeddi'r cyngor canlynol ar wared gwastraff personol yn ystod haint y coronafeirws:

- Dylid dodi gwastraff personol (fel hancesi papur a ddefnyddiwyd) a chlytiau / sychiadau glanhau untro yn ddiogel mewn sach sbwriel neu blastig tafladwy.
- Dylid dodi'r sachau hyn mewn ail sach arall, wedi'i chlymu'n dynn a'i chadw ar wahân i wastraff arall.
- Dylid dodi hon o'r neilltu am o leiaf 72 awr cyn ei ddodi yn eich sachau gweddillol "llwyd" arferol i'w casglu.
