THE COUNTY OF PEMBROKE (A477 PEMBROKE DOCK TO JOHNSTON ROAD & CLASS III (C3007) BURTON TO HAVERFORDWEST ROAD) (30MPH & 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2020

The Pembrokeshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order;
- Schedule 1 / Ref.1.10.0 / Location Haverfordwest to Burton Road of 'The County of Pembroke (Various Roads) (Restricted Roads & 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2017' will be revoked insofar as it relates to the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;
- 4. This Order may be cited as 'The County of Pembroke (A477 Pembroke Dock to Johnston Road & Class III (C3007) Burton to Haverfordwest Road) (30mph & 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2020' and shall come into operation on the 2nd day of November Two thousand and Twenty.

Schedule 1 30mph Speed Limit

Road C3007 at Burton

Length

from a point 203 metres west of the junction with the access road leading to the landing stage, west for 95 metres.

Schedule 2 40mph Speed Limit

A477 at the Cleddau Bridge

from a point 25 metres south of the junction with the C3007 to Burton, north to a point 195 metres north of that junction.

C3007 Cleddau Bridge to Burton

from the junction with the A477 to a point 298 metres west of the junction with the access road leading to the landing stage.
