

**THE COUNTY OF PEMBROKE (A477 PEMBROKE DOCK TO JOHNSTON ROAD
& CLASS III (C3007) BURTON TO HAVERFORDWEST ROAD) (30MPH & 40MPH
SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2020**

NOTICE is hereby given that Pembrokeshire County Council propose to make an Order under Section 84 and part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"). The effect of the Order will be to:

- i) extend the existing 40mph speed limit on the A477 at the northern end of Cleddau Bridge north for a distance of 177 metres;
- ii) introduce a 40mph speed limit on the C3007 from the junction of the A477 at the Cleddau Bridge to the 30mph limit at Burton;
- iii) extend the existing 30mph speed limit at the western end of Burton west for a distance of 47 metres.

The proposals are being promoted as part of a speed and road safety review that has been carried out in the Burton area.

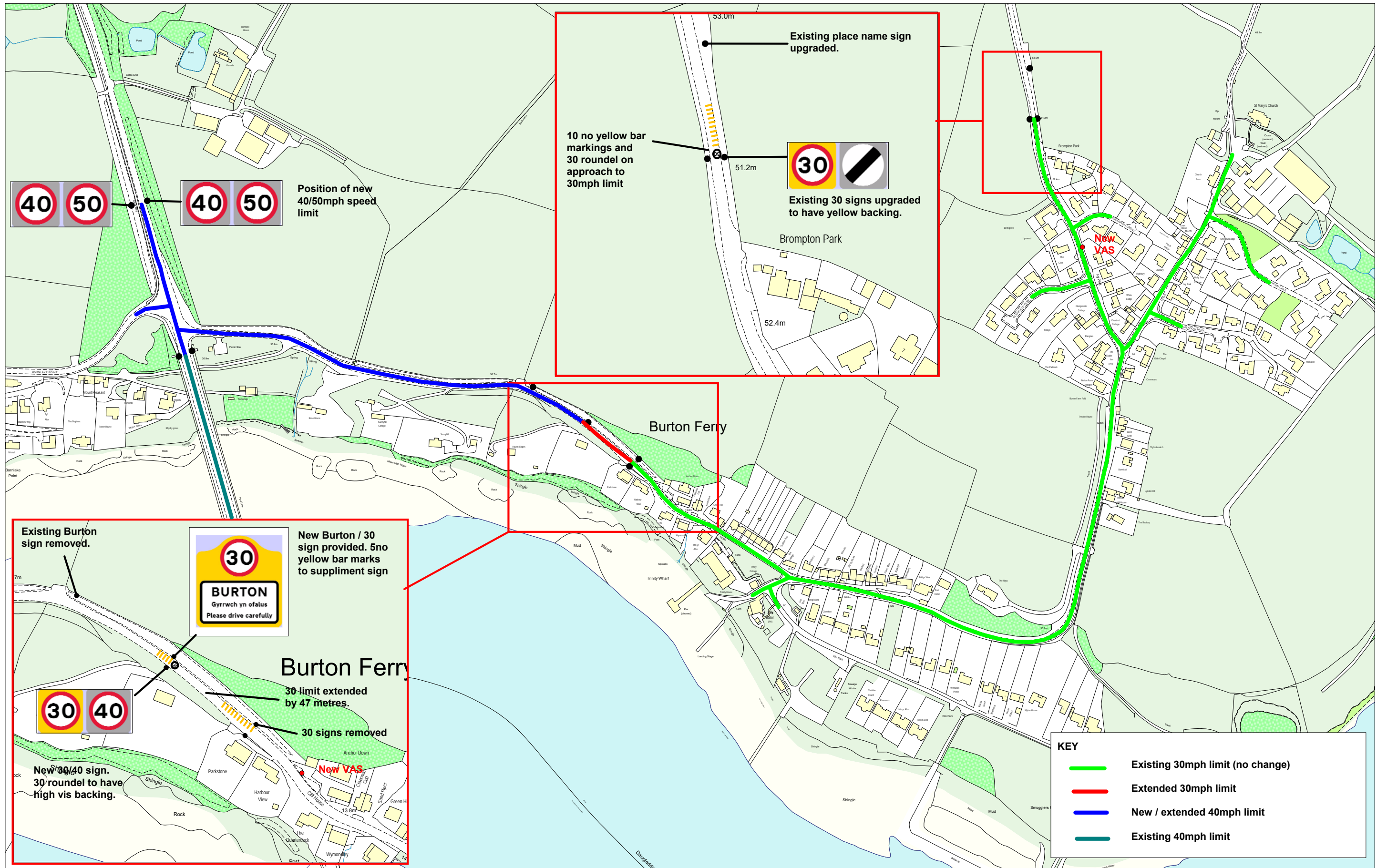

Statement of Reason

The extension of the 30mph speed limit and introduction of a 40mph 'buffer zone' on the C3007 approach to the western end of Burton are being promoted as a result of a road safety review that has been carried out on this length of road.

The speed limit measures will address concerns in respect of excessive entry speed into the village and will be supported by the introduction of Speed Indicator Devices (SiDs) which will relay a drivers speed and encourage compliance with the limit.

The extension of the 40mph speed limit on the A477 will see the limit extend north past the Burton junction to a point where the hatching and right / left turn lanes commence. This will improve road safety at this junction and any future bridge traffic management and control systems.

The Pembrokeshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order;
3. Schedule 1 / Ref.1.10.0 / Location - Haverfordwest to Burton Road of 'The County of Pembroke (Various Roads) (Restricted Roads & 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2017' will be revoked insofar as it relates to the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;
4. This Order may be cited as 'The County of Pembroke (A477 Pembroke Dock to Johnston Road & Class III (C3007) Burton to Haverfordwest Road) (30mph & 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2020' and shall come into operation on the xxth day of xxxx Two thousand and Twenty.

30mph Speed Limit**

Road

C3007 at Burton

Length

from a point 203 metres west of the junction with the access road leading to the landing stage, west for 95 metres.

**Schedule 2
40mph Speed Limit**

A477 at the Cleddau Bridge

from a point 25 metres south of the junction with the C3007 to Burton, north to a point 195 metres north of that junction.

C3007 Cleddau Bridge
to Burton

from the junction with the A477 to a point 298 metres west of the junction with the access road leading to the landing stage.
