

**THE COUNTY OF PEMBROKE (A478 BEGELLY TO TEMPLETON ROAD)
(30MPH / 40MPH & 50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2020**

NOTICE is hereby given that Pembrokeshire County Council propose to make an Order under Section 84 and part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"). The effect of the Order will be to:

- i) extend the existing 30mph speed limit on the A478 at the southern end of Templeton for a distance of 197 metres;
- ii) extend the existing 40mph speed limit on the A478 at the northern end of Begelly to a point 55 metres north of the junction with Ryelands Lane;
- iii) introduce a 50mph speed limit on that length of the A478 between the 30mph limit at Templeton, and, the 40mph limit at Begelly.

The extension of the speed limits at Templeton and Begelly will see both the Highways depot and outlying residential property being included within the respective speed limits. The proposed 50mph limit on that section of the A478 between Templeton and Begelly is being promoted following a speed limit review for this road.

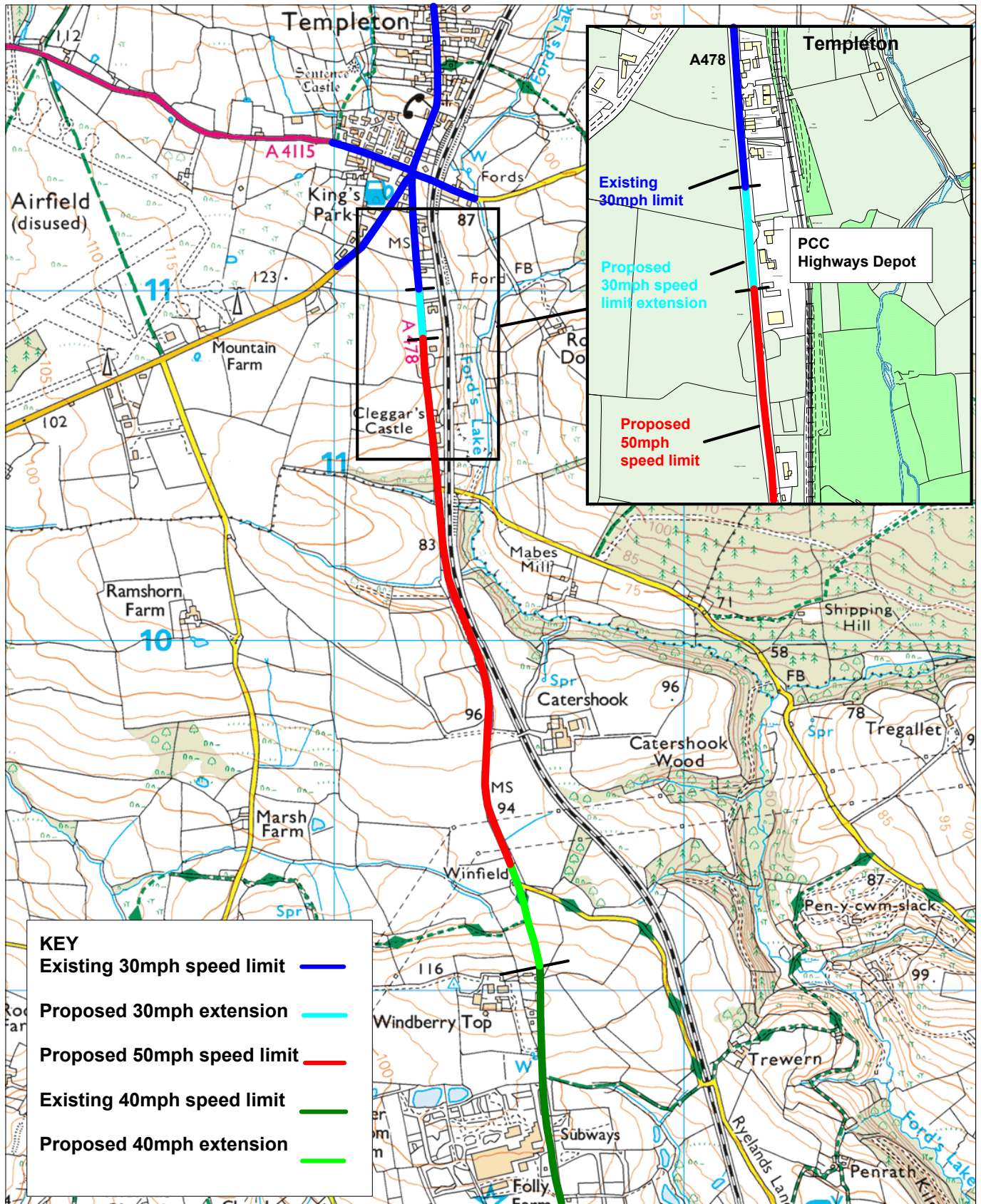

(30MPH / 40MPH & 50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2020**

Statement of Reason

The extension of the 30mph speed limit at Templeton will include the Highways depot access and is being promoted in recognition of the need for a reduction in vehicle speed at a point where continual vehicle movements into and out of the site takes place by various vehicle types including HGV traffic.

The 40mph speed limit at Begelly is to be extended from its current position to a point north of Ryelands Lane where it will see outlying property included within the limit.

In addition to the above measures a speed limit review has been carried out for the section of A478 between Begelly and Templeton. The review took into account the accident history, speed survey data, geometry of the road, and other factors including junctions, cattle crossing points, and vehicle laybys. The review concluded that the current limit should be reduced to 50mph in order to ensure that a safe and consistent speed distribution is maintained along this length of the A478.

**THE COUNTY OF PEMBROKE (A478 BEGELLY TO TEMPLETON ROAD)
(30MPH / 40MPH & 50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2020**

The Pembrokeshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order;
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule 3 to this Order.
4. Schedule 1 / Ref.1.92.0 / Location A478 of 'The County of Pembroke (Various Roads) (Restricted Roads & 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2017' will be revoked insofar as it relates to the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;
5. Schedule 3 Item i) of 'The County of Pembroke (Various Roads, Begelly) (Restricted Road / 30mph & 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2016' is hereby revoked.
6. This Order may be cited as 'The County of Pembroke (A478 Begelly to Templeton Road) (30mph / 40mph & 50mph Speed Limit) Order 2020' and shall come into operation on the xxth day of xxxx Two thousand and Twenty.

from a point 55 metres north of the junction with Ryelands Lane, north to a point 467 metres south of the junction with the A4115 at Templeton.
