



## **HELP PROTECT CUSTOMERS AND STAFF BY CORRECTLY DISPOSING OF YOUR WASTE**

Please help us to protect you, your staff and your customers as well as our waste and recycling staff by correctly disposing of waste cleaning products, personal waste and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

All disposable cleaning products and materials as well as PPE – including disposable aprons, facemasks, gloves – and personal waste such as tissues and wipes cannot be recycled and must be placed in your residual trade waste containers, these will be blue trade waste sacks and/or bins if your arrangement is with Pembrokeshire County Council. If you are using a third party for your waste you will need to check with them your arrangements as they may differ from the local authority waste collection service.

If someone within your place of business has had symptoms of Covid-19, please ensure personal waste items, PPE or items used to clean relevant areas are double bagged, left in a secure location for 72 hours (three days) before placing into residual trade waste bins/ sacks and placing them out for collection.

To keep your customers and staff safe, you are reminded to disinfect bin handles/lids before and after use and wash hands regularly.

Please follow these guidelines to protect yourself and others.

Together we can help you to keep your sites safe and maintain a good Trade Waste and Recycling Service for everyone during the Covid-19 situation.

During the COVID-19 lockdown many businesses stopped or suspended their trade waste agreements, therefore please ensure you let your trade waste operator know when you require collections to resume.

Please help keep Pembrokeshire's street's clean and litter free. Businesses are reminded that it is their responsibility to store their waste and recycling safely and securely within the boundary of their property until their collection day or they are able to take the waste materials to a licenced waste disposal site.

Businesses who wish to dispose of their waste at one of PCC's Waste and Recycling Centre's (WRC's) are reminded they are required to book an appointment for the disposal of commercial waste, have a valid waste carrier's licence and adhere to the WRC user guidelines. Charges apply for the disposal of commercial waste at WRC's, excluding a range of recycling.
